

Maths:

We will learn how to:

- Find the effect of dividing a one or two-digit number by 10 or 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones/units, tenths and hundredths.
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$.
- Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number.
- Compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal place.
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths and hundredths.
- Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.



English:


Over the half term we will be looking at different types of text including fiction and non-fiction. We will start by looking at a fiction text and the children will write an innovated version of the first chapter. Then we will be looking at explanation texts which will link in with our topic of Mountains as we will be writing an explanation text about the different types of mountains.



Science: Materials

This half term we are continuing to learn how to-

- Compare and group materials by state (solid, liquid, gas).
- Describe what happens to materials as they are heated and cooled.
- Measure temperature in degrees Celsius.
- Tell you about the water cycle

Topic- Mountains

This half term our topic is Geography based and we will be focussing on mountains. Within our Geography lessons, we will be developing our understanding of how mountains are formed, their key features and use our mapping skills to locate some of the different mountain ranges within the United Kingdom.

We will also be focussing on our art skills linking to our Geography topic. We will be developing our skill of drawing from life using detailed observations.



Computing: We will be looking at computer networks and will look at how we share data and information from our computers by the internet.
