We will learn how to:

- Add and subtract 2 two digit numbers.
- Recognise and use the inverse operation.
- Solve addition and subtraction problems using concrete objects and pictures.
- Identify and describe the properties of 2d shapes.
- Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.
- Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and tables.
- Tell and write time at o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.
